Role:

Additionally, he/she will be responsible for fostering an appropriate learning environment for the students they are assigned to.

- Establish a supportive and positive atmosphere with the students
- Adhere to systems and procedures of the classroom that have been established by the teacher
- Adapts and/or modifies classroom materials and assignments as appropriate to facilitate student learning
- Communicate pertinent information to the classroom teacher about student behavior, learning experiences, and parent communications
- Assists in supervision of students in the classroom, hallways, and playground, training students to follow classroom rules and love their neighbor
- Assist in keeping the classroom clean and organized

- Collaborate with other staff as needed to meet the needs of the student and help the day run smoothly
- Treat all information about the student as confidential, only to be shared as needed with others on the team
- Other duties as assigned

• Support faculty, families, students, and visitors through effective communication processes and problem-solving efforts maintaining confidentiality
