How Should I Conduct Myself on the Bus?

C – Christian – Conduct yourself in a manner pleasing to God!

C – Character – The fruits of the spirit are love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control

A – Accomplishment – Acceptable bus activities include homework, studying, reading books, uplifting songs, etc.

L – Leadership – Lead by example. Consider how your actions will be viewed by others.

I – Integrity -- Be someone who can be trusted and counted on in every situation!

O – Obedience – Follow directions. Listen to the bus driver!

N – Noble – Be honorable and respectful to everyone in your words and actions.

S – Speech – No unacceptable language or hurtful words.

E- Encouragement – Be a part of the team! Help to look out for the welfare of others.

X – Exclusion – The opposite of exclusion is inclusion – seek friendship with everyone on the bus.

P – Participation – Be mindful to follow the rules – No gum, food or drink except water. No electronics or cell phones. Rules can be adapted for special situations only with permission of the bus driver.

R – Ride – You can enjoy the ride! Please remain in your designated seat, sitting properly by facing forward with your hands and feet clear of the aisle. Remain seated when the bus is in motion!

E- Excitement – Keep noise level down to a level one. Visit quietly with neighbors. Voices should be off when pulling in and out of parking lots, at railroad crossings, and as directed by the bus driver.

S – Safety – Be AWARE and ALERT! Consider your approach to the bus, your actions on the bus and your actions as you depart. Be prepared to move in a quick and orderly fashion. Remember to dress appropriately for the weather. Report safety violations to the bus driver!

S – Service – Help by assisting others when needed. Be prepared to respond in an emergency!
